

What are chunks and what makes them such an effective way to learn a new language?

A chunk is a group of connected words that are treated as single concepts. Language chunks are known as lexical phrases and collocations. For example: on the one hand, as far as I am concerned, make a mistake, do homework etc.

The neuroscience proves that it is easier for us to remember lexical chunks than isolated words. Take smaller bits of information and combine them into more meaningful and memorable sentences.

Learn like children — the whole expressions and bits of language in context. It also means you do not have to study grammar to speak fluently. Instead, learn chunks and use them in your conversation naturally.
